Pre-Procedure Information

Thank you for choosing *SeaChelle's Permanent Makeup LLC*, my goal is to provide you with an exceptional experience. I place an emphasis on treating you with the highest standard of client care and excellence in all aspects of the procedure process. I have years of experience, the highest level of training, the most state-of-the-art equipment, and quality inks to give you a highly individualized procedure.

The policies and pre-procedure requirements are to ensure every client has adequate time to have their individual needs addressed. For your health, welfare, and a successful outcome of your new Permanent Makeup, please read and follow the guidelines listed below:

- 1.** Please call to inform me of the types of medications (including supplements) you use to determine if it is necessary to either refrain from taking them for 5-7 days prior to your procedure or if you will need an approval letter from your doctor. Unnecessary bleeding may result in the loss of ink in the skin. Here is a list of some medications to avoid: Advil (Ibuprofen), Aleve, Aspirin, herbs, or other prescribed or non-prescribed medications that may promote thinning of the blood. Please be advised, do not stop taking medication without a doctor's approval. **No alcohol or smoking 24 hours before the procedure.**
- 2.** If you have a tendency to swell, you can ask your doctor if he/she recommends that you take a something like an antihistamine 1 hour before your appointment. This is entirely up to the client and his/her doctor after they agree taking medication is appropriate for him/her.
- 3.** Please keep in mind that you may be more sensitive pre-menstrual, on your menstrual cycle, or during hormonal changes. You may want to schedule around this time. Every effort is made during your procedure to make you as comfortable as possible with the use of topical anesthetics.
- 4. LIP PROCEDURE:** The use of a prescribed medication is **required for anyone who has ever suffered from cold sores, fever blisters, or Herpes Simplex.** It is very common to not know if you have this condition, therefore, due to the "trauma" of the lip tissue, an outbreak can occur. For those who may suspect a possible outbreak even if you have never had one before, you can use the medication as a precaution, but it is not required. Be advised for those who know they are assessable to outbreaks, it is required to take this medication at least one day or more prior to the procedure. Not doing so may result in the rescheduling of your appointment and you will be charged a missed appointment fee. No exceptions.
- 5. PLEASE INFORM THE TECHNICIAN IF YOU MARK "yes" FOR ANY QUESTIONS ON THE MEDICAL CONSENT FORM.**
- 6. EYEBROW AND EYELINER PROCEDURES:** **do not tint or wax within 48 hours** of your procedure. **No Lash Extensions** are to be used during an eyeliner procedure and should be removed at least one week prior. In addition, you must discontinue the use of all eyelash growth enhancement products, i.e. **Latisse** or anything similar whether be prescribed or over-the counter medication 5-7 days before the procedure.
- 7.** Please feel free to arrive with your makeup on if you would like for me to see how you wear your customary daytime makeup. You may also bring in photographic examples to help express the desired shape and or color.

8. Be advised, your permanent makeup **will appear darker and more dramatic** for the first 3-7 days following your procedure. **This is normal and temporary.** I encourage you to call me if you have any concerns. Plan on wearing a *thin layer* of healing ointment for 7 days (I will give you enough to last during the week, including instructions). During the 7 days, give the area enough time to heal. No makeup on the treated areas for 7 days, including lipstick, mascara, foundation, powder, pencils, etc. Plan accordingly...

9. Keep in mind that your appointment is just for you and allows enough time for your procedure. I do not overbook and want to give you special treatment. A credit card deposit of \$50 will need to be paid either online at www.permanentmakeup.vpweb.com, in person, or via phone at least 1 week prior to the appointment to reserve your appointment. The balance is due the day of the procedure and can be paid either by check or cash (credit or debit cards can be taken, but not preferred). In order to provide quality attention to all clients, I need 2 or more business days to be informed of any cancellations or reschedules. Otherwise, late notices or no-shows will forfeit the refund and will not be credited back to the client. In addition, failure to disclose pertinent medical information that results in the last minute cancellation of a scheduled procedure will also result in a forfeiture of the deposit fee. In special circumstances, I will decide if a refund is warranted.

10. The results of any cosmetic procedure, including, but not limited to permanent makeup cannot be guaranteed. As such, whether or not a patient is satisfied with the outcome, there will be no refunds. The client and I will thoroughly go over shapes, colors, and possible outcomes to help you decide if permanent makeup is appropriate for you.

11. Please note, you **WILL** need a touch up 4-6 weeks after your initial procedure, the cost is \$75.00. This is to see how well you healed and do any possible tweaking to the tattoo; color or shape adjustments. Facial skin does not react to tattooing the same as body tattoos. To keep your tattoos as natural as possible, I tend to go a little lighter. Remember, going darker the second time is easier than going lighter the second time. Your face is important so I prefer to use caution.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

- a. Prior: Fill out the forms given to you, call me if you have any questions, concerns, or a list of medications/supplements you are taking.
- b. Bring the forms with you the day of the procedure.
- b. Follow all instructions and arrive on time.
- c. The day of the procedure, clean the area to be tattooed with the *Occuwipe* included in your packet. Once clean, gently exfoliate the area to be tattooed with the mascara wand provided.
- d. Take medication one hour prior to the appointment if you and your doctor deem necessary.
- e. Bring in samples or wear you makeup to help me determine your wants
- f. Lastly, relax.....

Clients are scheduled so I may give an adequate opportunity for you to have the best outcome. This will include a thorough consultation, designing of the areas to be tattooed, topical anesthetic, and time for the application. I pay special attention to details and want to give you a beautiful and natural looking permanent makeup that will compliment your own beauty. I look forward to seeing you at your appointment.....
